This sweepstake is an exempt lottery in Great Britain under the Gambling Act 2005 and is promoted by:

- All tickets must be sold at the location/time of the event but the draw can be at the event or after it has finished. Promoters of the lottery may deduct from the proceeds of the lottery no more than £100 for expenses and no more than £500 spent on prizes (other prizes may be donated). No rollovers. After the provision of prizes and reasonable expenses the balance of the proceeds will be donated to Guide Dogs by the promoter.
- The promoter is responsible for ensuring the sweepstake is run properly.
