- expenses and no more than £500 spent on prizes (other prizes may be donated). No rollovers. After the provision of prizes and reasonable expenses the balance of the proceeds will be donated to Guide Dogs by the promoter.
- The promoter is responsible for ensuring the sweepstake is run properly.
