- 1. With adult help, cut out a mask for each child along the pink dotted line.
- 2. On the blank reverse of the mask, children draw how they might be more inclusive or draw some of the people/dogs introduced in the assembly. Alternatively, they can glue on a multi-sensory collage to reflect that children with vision impairment might make more of using their fingers to touch, ears to hear and noses to smell.
- 3. Make two small holes on each side of the mask where the pink circles are marked.
- **4.** Thread some elastic, string or ribbon through the holes to tie the mask around the child's head.
