Valuable skills

Bella is always enthusiastic and willing, if there is a food treat involved! Thanks to this we've taught Bella the 'touch' command, in which she will touch my hand with her nose when asked. This









will be a valuable skill to her future owner as they will be able to locate her easily. This skill can be developed further at training school to encourage Bella to put her head through her harness.

We've also taught Bella to stay on the doormat when we return from a walk. This gives me enough time to grab a towel to rub her down. Getting her familiar with these tasks will be hugely beneficial to her future owner, as it will be easier for them to clean her to make sure she remains happy and healthy.
