New experiences

Bonnie has mastered many skills, so over the last few months, I've been bringing in new challenges by going to bigger and busier towns. Bigger towns provide the 'hustle and bustle' with lots more people, smells and sounds, adding an extra distraction for Bonnie. She's really taken this all in her stride, and I'm so proud of her progress!

To celebrate my birthday, Bonnie and I took a trip to the coast and Bonnie loved it! We spent lots of time on the beach and met her puppy pal Harvey. They loved digging in the sand and running in and out of the sea together. Even the cold weather didn't dampen their spirits!

Recently, I've introduced Bonnie to her TTouch harness, which allows for multiple points of contact on her body instead of just her collar. Bonnie barely even noticed that she was wearing it – I think because she's used to her puppy coat, wearing a harness felt very similar. However, she's learnt to walk beautifully on a loose lead whilst wearing her TTouch harness and I'm so pleased with how well she's doing.

I've been working hard on Bonnie's dog distraction, and I'm delighted with how well she's getting on! She used to get distracted very easily by other dogs, but now she remains calm, and even though she might have a little look at what's going on, it isn't long before she turns her attention back to me for a tasty treat!

Skills to master

Over the next few months, I'm continuing to work with Bonnie on the new skills we're learning in puppy classes. For example, one of these is called 'place', which asks Bonnie to lie on a blanket. She's only just started learning this skill, but Bonnie is picking it up really quickly – I'm so impressed.

I'm also going to be working on food manners with Bonnie. The goal is for Bonnie not to eat any food she may find without my cue. This is important so she learns not to eat any dropped foods that might not be appropriate for her when she is out and about with her future owner. Progress is slow, but I'm seeing small improvements over recent weeks which is great. Bonnie still tries to pick up food from the floor when we are in our local café, so that is our focus at the moment, but I can't really blame her; the food is delicious!
