I get a buzz every time I see a qualified guide dog working, even if it's not a pup I've necessarily worked with!

Marley is a very good pup. I've had black Labradors before and sometimes they can be more boisterous than other breeds. However, Marley is calm and chilled about most things. When out and about it is fairly easy with him; he is very confident already and isn't fazed by loud noises such as traffic outside.

Marley loves affection

Marley absolutely loves a cuddle and being stroked. He can get a bit soppy when you give him affection and will lie on his back with his paws in the air! His tail wags like crazy when he's happy.

It's great that Marley calms down so easily as it means I can take him to different places with no worry. He comes to church with me each week with no problems.

Marley's life at home

When Marley first settled in, he found nights a bit of a struggle. He didn't like to be left on his own in his cage and wanted to follow our other three pet dogs to their beds. However now he is completely fine and has continued to grow in confidence. Our retired guide dog Grace is a great influence on Marley and can show him the ropes on what he should do in the house. Grace is only two years old so she and Marley have a great time amusing each other. They love playing tug of war together!

Marley's training

Marley's training is going well. Prior to lockdown we went on one trip on the bus, which went surprisingly well for his first go – he didn't bat an eyelid! We were also able to visit a National Trust property when it was open. Marley had a great time and loved taking in the beautiful scenery.
