Niko is the seventh puppy that I've raised. I've been volunteering for Guide Dogs for thirteen years now, as I started off as a Fosterer. I really like puppy raising because I feel like I'm giving something back. Plus, it's very social, and I learn a lot about dogs and puppies!

All the puppies I've raised have been quite calm, and Niko is the same. He has a lovely personality. We give each of our new puppies a special monkey toy, and Niko carries it first thing in the morning to greet me. He's a very friendly and loving dog!

#### Niko is a confident pup

Niko is not fazed by anything. We were surprised at how mesmerised he was by the vacuum cleaner and didn't mind the noise at all. He has settled in well, and it helps that we have a withdrawn guide dog, Idris, who is older than him. Niko will often play with Idris, and then snuggle up to him afterwards. Although we do things separately with them, they have bonded nicely. If Niko sees that Idris has been rewarded for good behaviour, he then thinks 'Oh, I can do that too!' and will try to show off!

There is a fellow puppy in training, Gorby, who lives nearby, and Niko gets on wonderfully with him. We visit garden centres, supermarkets and let them have free runs together. He's quite a social pup and is also very gentle around children.

# Niko's training

Although puppy training classes were delayed because of Covid-19, Niko's basic obedience is progressing well. We have practised his 'wait' for food, and Niko is very patient. He's confident when going up and down the stairs and walks very nicely on a loose lead. Something he has been practising since day one is the verbal cue 'under'. If I'm sitting on a chair, Niko will lie down nicely under my legs.

Niko has a calm presence about him. When we visited a shopping centre I took him inside a lift for the first time – and he wasn't anxious at all! He's already managed to experience lots of different places, including visiting outdoor restaurants, stepping in and out of shops, and popping into the supermarket. Niko has taken everything in his stride.
