We live in an area where there is plenty of space for her to let off steam. Ruby has excellent recall and never goes far from us.

Ruby often attempts to help with the laundry by taking the socks out of the washing basket and running away with them – she thinks it's a game! We are trying to distract her with treats to prevent any further loss of socks and will let you know how it goes!

Confident pup

We have been taking Ruby to regular puppy classes, where she's learning basic obedience skills such as 'sit' and 'stay'. We've noticed that she's a lot more confident with learning new commands than the previous dogs we've puppy walked, which is really promising! Recently, Ruby has been learning the 'heel' command, where she is taught to walk nicely alongside her handler.
