#### Settling in

Alfie has settled in nicely and is very well behaved in the house. He loves playing tug of war and does very well with the command 'leave it'. He really makes us laugh with his funny antics. He will often rush around chasing his tail, and likes to lie on his back and hold toys between his front paws.

Alfie lives with our German pointer, Otto, and wirehaired Vizsla, Jaffa. The three of them love playing together and go charging around the living room. Alfie is quite a bit smaller than them at the moment, but still stands up for himself! His sister, Poppy, also lives just down the road and he loves playing with her and going to training classes together.









### Learning new things

Alfie is also doing very well in basic training and is consistently responding to 'sit' and 'down' commands. We are now working on 'stand' and his recall. We are very pleased with his progress. We have started taking Alfie out and about and I try to take him to lots of varied places. He has been on a train into town and a few bus rides. He is always very well-behaved.
