'Buddy Clock'

At home, Buddy has now moved from the crate to his own bed in the kitchen, although he loves lying out on the rugs during the day. He also now understands the command 'onto the bed'.

We use the phrase 'Buddy Clock' as Buddy has a

fantastic awareness of the time of day... for example every day, half an hour before tea-time, he waits by his bowl for his meal. After which, he knows it's playtime, picking up his favourite toy (a rubber wheel) and placing it on my lap.
